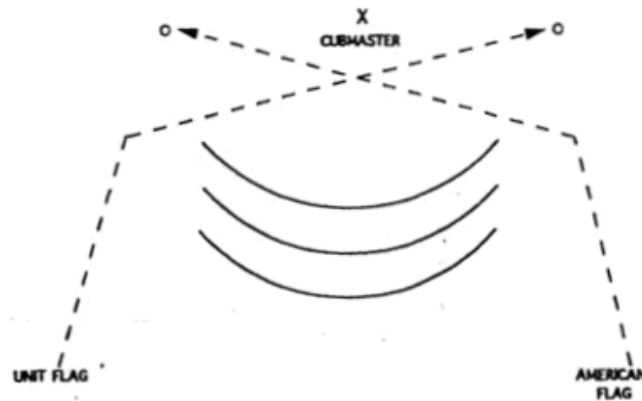


Cub Scout Pack 692

Flag Ceremony

The American Flag is posted to the speaker's right side.



Pack Members and Audience

Opening Ceremony

- **CM: Color guard, prepare to present the colors.**
- **CM: Will the audience please rise and remove all non-scouting headgear for the presentation of the colors.**
- **CM: Color guard, advance.**
 - The Color guard advances the flags per the diagram above.
 - The American flag crosses first.
 - The Pack flag pauses at the front corner of the audience until the American flag and respective scouts cross the audience.
 - The Pack flag follows in the same fashion.
 - All scouts (both flags) are lined up behind each other, off to the side of their respective flag.
- **CM: Cub Scout salute.**
 - All scouts (except flag bearers) salute.
- **CM: Color guard, post the colors.**
 - The flag bearers place the flags in the stands and salute.
- **CM: Please join me in the Pledge of Allegiance.**
- **All: (Recite the Pledge of Allegiance.)**
- **CM: Two.**
- **CM: Color guard, return to posts. The audience may be seated.**
 - The flag bearers turn toward the audience and walks to the back of the auditorium on the same side of their posted flag (outside the audience). The color guard (for each flag) follows in a snake formation.

Retiring the Colors

Cubmaster (CM):

- **CM: Color guard, prepare to retire the colors.**
- **CM: Will the audience please rise and remove all non-scouting headgear for the retiring of the colors.**
- **CM: Color guard, advance.**
 - The color guard approach their respective flags (they do NOT cross) and grasp the poles.
 - All scouts (both flags) are lined up behind each other, off to the side of their respective flag.
- **CM: Color guard, retire the colors. Cub Scout salute.**
 - The flag bearers turn toward the audience and walk to the back of the auditorium on the same side of their posted flag (outside the audience). The color guard (for each flag) follows in a snake formation.
- **CM: Two.**
 - Cubmaster ends the meeting.
